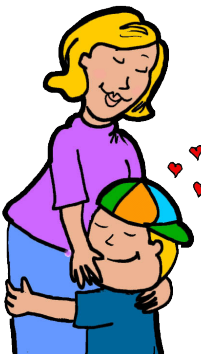

May is upon us and we are preparing for the new school year. Please stop by the daycare office to make sure your child is on the roster for the school year.

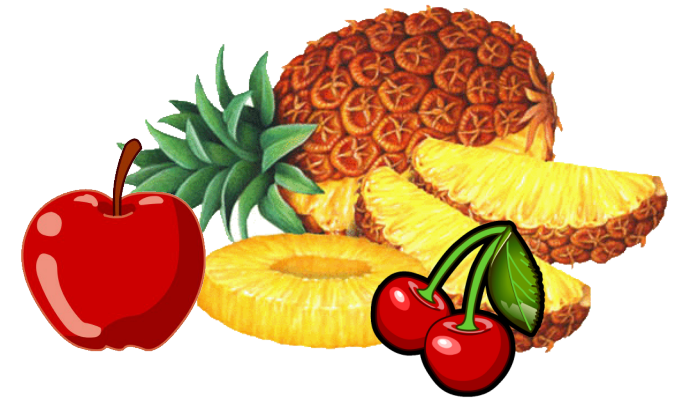
AFTER-SCHOOL CARE

RECIPE

Apple Salad

12 oz Cool Whip
 1/3 cup flour
 1 cup sugar
 1 lg. can crushed pineapple & juice
 1/4 stick of butter
 Cherries to garnish
 4-5 red apples, chopped bite size
 8 oz grated cheese
 1 cup chopped pecans



Cook pineapple with juice and sugar until thick. Remove from heat. Stir in butter until melted. Mix with apples coating completely. Cover with Cool Whip to seal it. Cover tightly and refrigerate overnight. When ready to serve, top with cheese and chopped pecans, garnish with cherries.
